Atheism/Religion VS The Untold Truth

First we have to establish that the entire scriptures are prophetic and allegorical, made up of abstract stories, concealing spiritual knowledge, therefore they cannot be taken literally. Secondly it is to prove that they were prearranged and in a fragmentary mode, divided into three diverse levels and magnitudes of higher spiritual interpretation, as three dimensional, expressed as the things not seen, which are hidden within the one level, the literal?

The Lord God reveals that His living word, "the Logos", the Excellency of the knowledge of Christ is spiritual and only spiritually can be discerned, expressed not in words which man's wisdom teaches, but which the Spirit teaches, comparing spiritual things with spiritual. 1 Corinthians 2:13.

All Scripture is given by the inspiration of God, and is useful for teaching, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness, 2 Timothy 3:16. The scriptures also stress, the natural man does not receive the things of the Spirit of God, for they are foolishness to him; nor can he know them, because they are spiritually discerned. 1 Corinthians 2:14.

The Author of the Biblical literature, the "Author of salvation" clearly testifies that all things written and spoken, only spiritually can be discerned. For centuries there has been a lack of spiritual understanding of their allegorical language and structure, which most people insist to choose to take each and every "earthly" story literally, ignorantly believing that all the Biblical "earthly" stories were natural events and therefore, the historical records of those events.

Furthermore, the Author continues to testify that all scripture is God inspired, which means that, in order to understand what one is reading, one has to be spiritually motivated. By having the sincere desire to understand the spiritual magnitude of the word it can only be received by the opening and elevation of the mind, by the awakening of one's conscience, which is the meaning of the expression "God inspired", such as Paul's allegory: snatched unto the third heaven.

Paul in order to give food for thought he questions: whether inside the body or outside the body? He purposely says I do not know; only God knows... Paul wanted to reveal that in order to reach the higher spiritual interpretation of God's word, "the third heaven knowledge", the Paradise of God only happens through the elevation of the mind by divine inspiration. At the same time though, Paul also reveals the two sides of the man in Adam, since he is the only one who receives the two seeds of the tree of knowledge. Wherefore, outside the body refers to the outward man (carnal); whilst inside the body refers to the inward man (spiritual).

Jesus testifies:

You search the Scriptures, for in them you think you have eternal life; and these are they which testify of me; but you are not willing to come to me that you may have life. John 5:39-40

The above declaration clearly reveals that without approaching the author first "You are not willing to come to me" and follow all His instructions, there is no way possible that any man will be able to understand the hidden of the scriptures. This confirms He is the only one who can open and elevate one's mind to all the spiritual knowledge of His word and the mysteries of His Kingdom.

To understand that when Jesus refers to the scriptures, He includes the Hebrew and the Hellenic writings, Moses and the Prophets and their fulfillment, since both the Hebrew and the Hellenic writings testify about Him. Jesus establishes He is the One from the very beginning, from the Genesis creation, who walks invisibly right through the entire scriptures, portraying all the Biblical characters, from the Garden all the way to Bethlehem.

Here He proves, with the two disciples who were on their way to Emmaus: And beginning from Moses and all the Prophets, He explained to them what was said in all the Scriptures concerning himself. Luke 24:27

The resurrected Christ did not say; now that I have fulfilled the law and the prophets, what was written and what was spoken before, are no longer relevant, since He establishes that only through them the real Christ manifests. Moses wrote about me...and what was spoken by the Prophets... and since He is the One who portrays all the Biblical characters...

This yet again is another example to ascertain that the only way possible for a man to come to understand the spiritual magnitude of the entire scriptures is only through the teaching of Moses and of the prophets, by Jesus Christ through the opening "elevation" of the mind, symbolically expressed as breaking the bread.

Then he opened their minds so they could understand the Scriptures. Luke 24:45

Wherefore, without God's inspiration, the penny will never drop and no one will ever reach their height, depth, length and breadth. This refers to the four dimensional levels and the higher spiritual interpretation of each level.

For this very reason intentionally, the Author within the book of Acts makes it clear that the scriptures must not be taken literally, puts forward this simple question:

Do you understand what you are reading? Acts 8:30

John 3:12 clearly reveals that there is a vast difference between the earthly stories and the heavenly, referring to the "things not seen". Faith is the pathway, given by God and is not someone's personal beliefs and assumptions, but "the narrow door of one's mind", the narrow door which only Christ can open for the true disciple (student-learner) to enter into the spiritual knowledge of God's word, expressed as the stairway "ladder" to heaven. This only happens through the elevation of the mind, passing, travelling through the corridors of time, unto the third heaven knowledge.

The narrow door and the sorrowful way, which leads unto life and few, are they who find it.

Faith: is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence "the assurance" of things not seen; the hidden, the invisible higher and four dimensional knowledge of God's word, which cannot be seen by the untrained eye and the closed minded.

Up to now the three main monotheistic religions have taken the entire scriptures literally and interpreted them on personal assumptions, which is

proven by their never ending theatrical rituals and stage performances which have been proven to be totally meaningless and fruitless and have nothing to do with the true God of the scriptures. The blind have been leading the blind and for many centuries now.

According to the religious non foundational doctrines; God somehow created a male clay puppet and breathed into him and started walking and God decided to name the clay puppet Adam. Whilst most men due to these fairy tale and irrational declarations remained ignorant to the very fact that the Genesis creation account only describes the process of the spiritual creation of the man of God, as the spiritual evolution and as a parallel to the evolutionary stages of the natural.

On the other hand, since it has been disclosed that all the species and the human race came through evolution, immediately the sceptics assumed there is no God, since religion taught every man that Adam was the first man to walk the planet earth fully intelligent contrary to the evidence of the natural evolution. This also opposes the Genesis account which in reality only depicts the creation of the earthy man into a living soul and the spiritual creation of the man of God and not the natural creation. The Hellenic writings confirm that **Adam is the type of things to come**, clearly confirming that the creation of Adam was and still is **prophetic and symbolic** and only points to the one man in Adam. The one man who is willing to bear Adam's image as Adam himself and only by following the instructions of the book of life, beginning from Moses and the Prophets all the way...

As Jesus the Christ walks right through the entire scriptures, so must the true learner...

To me you don't come... Lift up your cross and follow me...

Through lack of spiritual discernment of the divine instructions, it has never been realised that the resurrection of the dead only refers to the resurrection of the mortal soul into a living soul "alive from the dead", while man is alive and breathing and not after one is dead and buried.

Paul, in order to reveal what "the death of the flesh" really represents and that man is a mortal soul; he declares: whilst he was alive and breathing that "he had died" and he continuous, to say that, with Christ I was crucified and I no longer live, but Christ who lives in me. Paul obviously was not physically dead but refers to the death of the flesh and the resurrection

of the mortal soul into a living soul and not popping out from the grave which is only full of broken and rotten bones.

Paul also testifies that he was born before time wherefore; everything written and said was prophetic.

The Genesis account reveals that man is mortal and needs to be created "resurrected" from mortality into immortality as a living soul, as the perfect "Anthropos" of God, alive to God which is the will of God and the reason why God gave His word to mankind in the first place.

If all of us from birth were living "immortal" souls, we did not need salvation of the soul, since the immortal soul does not die. According to the religious fallacies, Adam sinned towards God and fell. However, it is written that he, who is born of God, does not sin, because God's seed remains within him.

The scriptures confirm that the carnal natural man from birth is a child of wrath, but why? Because man, from nature is just as any other animal and a territorial predator, whilst the only difference is that man is the crown of the natural evolution.

Thousands of years ago, long before modern science, God revealed that man is an animal and a mortal soul and not immortal; and neither was man created in the image and likeness of God.

For what happens to the sons of men also happens to animals; one thing befalls them: as one dies, so dies the other. Surely, they all have one breath; man has no advantage over animals, for all is vanity. Ecclesiastes 3:19

Was a lion or a tiger created into a living soul and in the image and likeness of God? Obviously not... neither was man...

Jesus within the Hellenic writings again confirms that man is a mortal soul saying to a certain man: let the dead bury their own dead, clearly revealing that man's soul is dead. How can the dead physically bury the dead?

The scriptures clearly inform us that our temporary existence is vanity, meaningless, unless there is resurrection of the dead, of the dead soul that is; and therefore, necessary to be created into a living soul, if only we so wish, it is not compulsory; it is every man's individual choice.

Whilst the Lord's advice, is to seek God's kingdom and righteousness and everything else shall be added onto you, meaning that the Lord will add to us the understanding of the hidden of His divine word, the heavenly riches.

The only difference between man and the rest of the animal kingdom is enhanced intelligence, since man is on top of the evolutionary pyramid, the crown of God's natural creation and the only one who is abundantly gifted the power and use of reason, capable to create ideas, to choose and to invent. The only one who is competent: not only to understand, but also to describe his natural surroundings, as also capable to grasp the spiritual.

God offers us salvation of our soul by the promise of eternal life, which means that God cares for us more than we think. For God to empty Himself and to take the form of a man, but only within the scriptural context and environment though and not physically as a man, the paramount issue which hasn't been understood as yet.

This perception of the declaration "God manifests in the flesh" only becomes understood by spiritual discernment, through the opening of the mind, when one gets to know the hidden of the divine word, the things not seen.

Jesus the Lord: the only mediator between man and God, the Eternal Spirit in the order of Melchizedek, without Father, without Mother and without Genealogy, having neither beginning of days nor end of life, but **made like the Son of God**. The Godhead in Christ Jesus... **the Son of God**, the role model and the example for every man who has ears and wants to hear...

When Moses asked God to tell him His name, God said: "I AM THAT I AM", I am the Existent One"... the Living One...the Infinite Spirit...

Up to now almost everyone was made to believe that God became a natural man and walked on planet earth, considering the birth of Jesus as a natural birth and that He was born of a natural woman, although the birth of Jesus denotes an unnatural birth. This is only understood through Spiritual discernment and since Jesus is the spiritual seed of God and can only be born "manifest" in a man, the man in Adam...

Now Jesus and His disciples went out to the towns of Caesarea Philippi; and on the road He asked His disciples, saying to them, "Who do men say that I am" Mark 8:27

For centuries now people have been reading the above quote as an actual event and as historic record, without ever realizing its spiritual connotation,

imagining and believing that Jesus physically went for a stroll to Caesarea Philippi, just to ask His disciples; what do men say that He is? Without ever understanding that the entire scenario is invisible and prophetic and is to teach and to reveal to the man who wants to listen, how, Jesus as the spiritual seed enters his heart; and who in reality conceives the spiritual seed and above all how is Jesus born within him?

Caesarea first of all, is given as a cryptic clue, and translates as "severed-detached" denoting that Jesus' birth is as a Caesarean birth, denoting an unnatural birth. Whilst Philippi, yet again a cryptic clue, translates as "lover of horses" which symbolically represents the man who loves the Judgements of the laws of God, the true disciple, denoting the man under the disciplines of God's laws and who is the only one who receives the spiritual seed and the only one who can give birth to Jesus.

Wherefore, the higher interpretation reads that Jesus as the spiritual seed of God descends in the heart and mind of the man in Adam, (by the awakening of man's inner conscience)

The scriptures yet again purposely use Philip which translates as "lover of horses" the one to put forward the question:

Do you understand what you are reading?

But let's prove the misinterpretation of Jesus' birth and God manifesting in the flesh through spiritual discernment and understanding.

Luke's genealogy account (3:38) confirms that Adam was **the first son of God.** Luke begins with Jesus and goes all the way back to Adam, purposely to unite Jesus with Adam as one man.

Jesus calls Himself the son of Anthropos, the son of man, as the same seed of Adam, which prophetically reveals that Jesus is the one who portrays the first Adam as in the image and example of the natural, the fleshy man, who has to be created into a living soul, through the adoption process. Jesus as the Alpha Adam is the type of things to come... therefore, a prophetic declaration...

God is the One who emptied Himself by taking the form of a man in the face of Jesus Christ, but only within the Biblical environment and not as a physical man and expressed in past tense, for the simple reason that God's word has been written and established. Jesus is to be the example, the way, the truth who reveals God's eternal life, with the aim to educate man and

reveal to him that he is a mortal soul and needs to be created into a living soul, if he so desires and accepts God's offer of eternity. The living soul is an eternal part of the living God Himself who is Spirit, the only One who can resurrect man's animal mortal soul into a living soul by the power of His eternal Spirit promised through His living word.

This substantiates that Adam was not a natural man and most definitely not a clay puppet, but God Himself as Jesus the Christ the one who portrays the Alpha Adam as also the Omega Adam. God emptied Himself, taking the form of a man as Adam to serve and to teach the earthy man, His will and works. Jesus, as the Alpha Adam and Christ as the Omega Adam (Jesus as the living soul and Christ as the living Spirit)

Jesus as the first Adam and as the earthy man prophetically crucifies the old nature of the flesh, beginning from the tree of knowledge (suspended between the two branches of good and evil, cursed is the one who hangs on the tree) as the example to every earthy man. Christ is the one who is raised as the last Adam, as the perfect spiritual man, the life giving Spirit... **Sown in dishonoured to be raised in glory...** referring to the death of the old animal nature "death of the flesh, undressing the old man" and the resurrection of the mortal soul into a living soul, putting on the righteous new man, through the adoption process as the new creation, being built upon the rock foundation doctrine of Christ.

Jesus, by portraying the first Adam and the earthy man, illustrates (as the example for the man who wants to hear) the total transformation of the man with the living soul on the Mount of Metamorphosis and only when Moses and Elijah, who represent the two witnesses who reveal Christ. Elijah represents the prophetic word and all the prophets, proving that only through the teaching of Moses and of the prophets one learns all the instructions and the spiritual insights of the word and is able to reach the status of the real Jesus Christ, when full of age and spiritual maturity.

God emptied Himself, taking up the form of a man and therefore God is the one who sacrifices Himself to teach and to enlighten man, concerning his human condition and that without God man is completely naked, destined to die and no different to the rest of the earthly creatures. As the example, Jesus as Adam portrays the earthy man, after he ate the fruit of enlightenment of good and evil and as soon as his eyes were opened,

immediately he realized that he was naked, he faced reality, the reality of his human condition and what was his destiny; Adam became afraid, he was overcome by the fear and guilt of permanent death... beginning of knowledge and wisdom fear of God...

Jesus clearly confirms that He is one with the Father, as also Christ is one with the Father, proving beyond doubt that Jesus Christ is one, as God is One, establishing that God is the one who portrays the role of the two Adams, as the anointed saviour Himself. Wherefore, the two Adams, the Alpha Adam and the Omega Adam are one man. Jesus as the spiritual seed and the living soul is born in a man, denoting the resurrection of the mortal soul, **but until Christ the heavenly man is formed in him**...until he is transformed as the Christ himself...as the living spirit... denoting that as the living soul he has a spiritual body not made by hands to be dressed with, prepared in heaven by God expressed as God's dwellings

God is God of the living, of the living soul, which is a living portion of God Himself, a portion of the Eternal Spirit.

Jesus knocks on the door, the door of the mind and heart; and whoever opens to Him, He shall enter into Him and He will sup with him...

Jesus was not born of a natural woman, since Mary represents any true disciple with the pure "virgin heart" after being chastised by the laws of God and since in the Lord there is neither male nor female; Jesus can only be born in a house of bread, since He is the heavenly bread. Wherefore, Bethlehem represents the one man in Adam with the chastised virgin heart, as the House of Bread, which is the literal meaning of the name Bethlehem. This is given as a cryptic clue; therefore, the Biblical Bethlehem has nothing to do with the geographical town of Israel, but represents the man in Adam.

But for Jesus to be born in Bethlehem, the walls of Jericho must be demolished first, which represents the carnal man of the animal nature and not the natural city of Jericho.

The conceit of the carnal man's heart is as a high wall; and as a fortified city which only the laws of God can demolish. God blends His word within man's history and geographical locations, but intangible. This is the reason why there is no natural evidence to substantiate any of the Biblical stories,

even the three million Israelites who supposedly perished in the wilderness...

If only this allegorical aspect of the scriptures was to be understood, either by the religious or by the non-religious, possibly they could wake up from the deep sleep and stop taking the scriptures literally.

Wherefore, Jericho and Bethlehem only represent the one man in Adam, who receives the spiritual seed, the good seed planted in his mind and heart, as the good earth and virgin heart after he has been scourged and chastised by the laws of God, through the purification of the mind and heart. This is expressed as the renewal of the mind, fully prepared and fully furnished to give birth to the new man in the image and likeness of God, as the Christ, obtaining the mind of Christ expressed as the spirit of the mind. The reason why, no man can put new wine in an old wineskin, referring to the old head of the carnal man who can neither obtain nor contain the spiritual teaching; expressed as the new wine... unless a change of mind and heart takes place, as a new wineskin.

This is why it is written: Blessed are the pure in heart, because they shall see God, God manifesting in a man, and not God manifesting in the natural as a man, but God within a man. God only dwells in a humble man's heart... and refers to the seed of God dwelling within a man. Wherefore, only the one man in Adam is the temple of God and the temple of the eternal Spirit.

According to the original Hebrew text God said: "Let him be light and he was light" strictly directed to a man, directed to Adam who is portrayed by Jesus, as to a third person masculine and not, let there be light. The light refers to the Excellency of the knowledge of Christ as the spiritual enlightenment. Wherefore, only through the spiritual knowledge and wisdom of God; man can reach God, with a pure conscience and circumcised, humble heart and not circumcision of one's private parts, which is the result when the scriptures are taken literally, and can lead to all kinds of delusions and atrocities.

Up to now religion and atheism ignore the fact that Christ is the one who walks invisibly right through the entire scriptures, portraying all the Biblical characters and the reason He says that he is the First and the Last. God Himself as Jesus the Christ the one who portrays the role of the two Adams,

Jesus as the first Adam, the earthy man, in the likeness of the sinful flesh, born of the flesh, symbolically expressed as born of a woman and under the law, who crucifies "the sinful flesh", the guilt of death.

Wherefore, only the man in Adam is the one who undresses the old nature, the mortal soul, after he eats the fruit of spiritual knowledge, (the Holy writings of wisdom) to be resurrected as a living soul and as the Christ who is the Omega Adam, the heavenly man who is the living Spirit and only as the example to the man who becomes co-planted with Him. Co-planted first with Jesus on the tree of Knowledge and co-planted after with Christ on the tree of Life. And as we have borne the image of the earthy man, we shall also bear the image of the heavenly man, yet again a prophetic declaration and only applies and concerns the one man in Adam, the man who coveted the knowledge of God and came under the power of the laws of God by breaking the commandment you "shall not covet". Because if you eat the fruit of the tree you shall die, pointing to the death of the flesh, of the old animal nature. Paul as the teacher confirms: Us, who have taken the decision of the death sentence, referring to the death of the flesh, the death of the animal nature and not the death of one's natural body.

What is sin towards God?

Sin in the flesh, only represents the guilt of death as the flesh carries the stigma of death applying to the man who receives the law, because only through the knowledge of the law, sin, guilt of death manifests. Sin denotes the nakedness of the mortal soul in the eyes of God. The Tabernacle in the wilderness represents a man walking in the wilderness (the voice of one crying in the wilderness) receiving the knowledge of God, dressed, in animal skins; God covered Adam, "male and female", with animal skins to cover up his nakedness.

No man ever, was a sinner or is a sinner towards God, but only the one man in Adam, the one man who covets the knowledge of God and who dares to eat the two seeds of the tree of knowledge. Also, the one man who shall bear the image of the earthy and of the heavenly Adam and no one else, since no man is under the laws of God and therefore, not a law breaker. Therefore, the law only applies to the law breaker and you shall not covet the fruit of tree of knowledge because you shall die and the spiritual knowledge shall crucify your fleshy carnal man.

Every carnal man on this earth, without God, without being created into a living soul hasn't a spiritual body to be dressed with and he is destined to die; and no religious prayers are going to package him to the abstract garden, which does not exist.

God warns man: He wants every man to be saved from his animal nature, if only man wants to. Only the man in Adam is the man who receives the riches in Christ, his heavenly treasure.

Since birth, every natural man's eyes are focused only on the earthly and temporary things, "the world of sight, his prison house" on all the vanities of this world, according to man's traditions and beliefs and empty dreams, according to the system of this world which is guilty of corruption. The purpose of God's word "the Logos of truth" is given to us in order to open our eyes, as an awakening call to the reality of our temporary life.

The scriptures for this very reason put forward another question as food for thought:

If there is no resurrection of the dead?

If there is no resurrection of the soul then all is vanity, every man's life is completely pointless, whilst on a spherical space ship continually encircling the Sun twenty four hours a day, going nowhere. Each and every one of us is stamped with an expiry date, whilst the scriptural answer is this: let's eat and drink because tomorrow we die which yet again is food for thought, aiming to stir up and to provoke man's subconscious mind and realize that without God our life at the end of the day is futile.

Also, in continuation another important question is put forward: **who shall deliver me from this body of death?** The answer: Jesus Christ, since the promise of God is eternal life, by the resurrection of the dead soul. If only, man wishes to undress his carnal animal nature by demolishing the walls of Jericho, and to put on the divine nature, as Bethlehem, as the new man "the absolute Anthropos" and only through the knowledge and understanding of the laws and will of God, expressed as the renewal of the mind... wherefore, crucifixion of the flesh denotes the undressing of the old carnal man and not nailed on two planks, whilst the water baptism represents the receiving and judgements of the laws of God and not

physically dipped in water, the theatrical ritual of the religious, which in reality is meaningless and fruitless.

To believe is to know and to know is to understand perfectly, wherefore, for a man to say that he believes blindly is like walking in a thick dark forest at night.

The scriptures inform us that we are animals with a mortal soul and live in corruption and all things around us, are just as corrupt and temporary, nominated as **the valley of the shadow of death**.

Proving and beyond doubt that no man ever was created a living soul and in the image and likeness of God and therefore, necessary to be created into a living soul and in the image and likeness of God now. This is the very purpose and intention for God to give His word of truth to us in the first place.

The word of truth, the Logos was specifically written to give us patience and comfort and to enrich us with the living hope of eternal life. "The eyes of your mind being enlightened; so that you may know what the hope of His calling is"...

From man's temporary natural existence unto everlasting spiritual existence, from the lowly state and frame of mind of the earthly Adam we shall be transformed and be dressed with the divine nature of God. By becoming a living soul will be counted worthy of the heavenly treasure, awarded with a spiritual glorious body in likeness and image of the Eternal Spirit, the Existent One...

Some atheists, because they take the scriptures literally, claim that from oblivion man came into temporary existence and from temporary existence back into oblivion. That idea sounds somewhat discouraging and hopeless by accepting death as a last resort, living a meaningless life, without purpose whatsoever "if we live like an animal we shall die like an animal" Why spent and why waste a whole life time studying to leave behind the legacy of atheism. Whether one believes or not, it does not make any difference at the end of the day, unless one is prepared to take on the decision to sacrifice his carnal self in order to gain the divine nature. If you loose your life, you shall gain your life... what will a man give in exchange for his soul?

Concerning the grotesque idea of reincarnation, is a complete nonsense and a sickly thought. What is the point for the soul to live again on this earth and in another human body or even in a form of lower species and suffer as a final destination the same course of death yet again?

We are animals already and God wants to transform us and put on His divine nature, why does any man want to come back again, especially as a monkey or as a rat.

How sad, how miserable it is to think and to accept that the course of this natural life alone, was to exist for a few miserable years, when there is such an amazing and glorious promise made by the eternal God, offering man "the gift" of eternal life and immortality, through the abundance of His grace and love of an everlasting and incorruptible life, made possible through Christ Jesus for the one man who wants to... the open invitation... the good news of salvation, of the (Evangelion) the Book of eternal life.
